Ms. Walker is the Environmental Administrator for the DoD and Brownfields Partnerships Section in the Waste Cleanup Program, Division of Waste Management. She joined the Department in January of 2006 and since that time has been the Program Manager for the Florida Brownfields Program. Ms. Walker is responsible for management and development of the state Brownfields Program. She works closely with the local governments, EPA, the Department of Economic Opportunity, and Enterprise Florida, Inc., to promote the program and provide incentives for redevelopment and clean up of brownfield sites. In late 2011, her responsibilities were expanded to include management of the grant and Department staff that support the Defense and State Memorandum of Agreement (DSMOA). Ms. Walker works directly with the Air Force, Navy, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the EPA to manage environmental restoration of contaminated sites at Florida's military installations. Prior to joining FDEP, Ms. Walker worked as an environmental consultant for 20 years. As a consultant, she managed a wide variety of contracts and projects including CERCLA investigations, RCRA compliance audits, stormwater permitting and compliance, Targeted Brownfields Assessments, and NEPA public involvement tasks. Ms. Walker has a Bachelor of Science degree in Biological Sciences from Florida State University.
